Elements of a Plot

Exposition	The part of the story when characters and setting are introduced.
Conflict	The struggle or problem.
	*Character versus character
	*Character versus nature
	*Character versus society
	*Character versus themselves
3 Stages of Action	Rising Action-Events that increase tension and events that lead up to the climax.

Resolution	Climax-The high point of the story. Usually at the climax, you can foreshadow the story's ending. Falling Action-Tension decreases and everything settles down. The conflict has been resolved.
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Each question should be answered in paragraph format. Six questions and six paragraphs should be turned in. Use details from the book and your own experiences to answer questions completely. Work must be typed, in Times New Roman font, 12 size font, 1.5 spacing (this is the standardized requirement for work turned in for High School).

3. What is the main conflict in this story?
4. Describe the rising action in the story.
5. Describe the climax of the story.
6. Describe the falling action.
