**Aaron Cole Statistics:**

Aaron, a three-year starter, and team captain, helped lead the Calvary Knights to a second place finish in the GICAA South Division in 2017. Furthermore, he guided them to an appearance in the 2017 State Quarterfinals. This is the highest region finish the program has reached since the boys' soccer program was reestablished five years ago. Playing varsity soccer since the 8th grade, Aaron was a defensive stalwart and leader for a squad that has qualified for the state playoffs five straight years as well as a Final Four appearance in 2014. Due to his stifling style of defensive play, Aaron was always matched up against the opposition's most talented scorers. Outside of the soccer fields, Aaron was also a leader in the classroom, boasting a 3.93 GPA. He is a member of the Beta Club, National Honors Society, and participated in Fellowship of Christian Athletes events.
