CALVARY COVID-19 PROTOCOL

IF YOU...

- Live in the same household as a person who tested positive for COVID-19
- Care for a person with COVID-19
- Have been within 6 FT of a person with COVID-19 for 15 minutes or more without safety measures in place (masks, shields, dividers)
- Have had direct contact with the secretions from a person with COVID-19 (coughed on, kissed,

THIS IS CONSIDERED DIRECT EXPOSURE

Student or employee action

Stay home for 14 days

If symptoms develop, contact your physician

May return to school after 14 days and when fever and symptom free for 72 hours

For known exposure, the requirement is to self-quarantine for 14 days even if a test is negative. A negative test does not negate the 14 day quarantine requirement.

IF YOU...

-Have tested positive for a COVID-19 PCR or rapid test

THIS IS WHAT YOU DO WITH A POSITIVE TEST

Student or employee action

Stay home

Notify physician and monitor symptoms

May return to school after 10 days and when fever and symptom free for 72 hours

School action

Identify direct exposure contacts

Communicate with school community

Follow COVID-19 direct exposure protocol

IF YOU...

- Have fever or chills
- Are experiencing nausea
- Have been vomiting
- Have diarrhea
- Have a cough
- Are experiencing shortness of breath
- Are experiencing fatigue
- Have muscle or body aches
- Have a headache
- Have a sore throat
- Have congestion/runny nose
- Have lost taste or smell

YOU MAY HAVE SYMPTOMS

Student or employee action

Stay home from school

Contact Physician

May return when fever and symptom free for 72 hours

School action (if symptoms appear at school)

The nurse will evaluate symptomatic students and employees

Student

Parents called

Student will be sent home

Employee

Employee will be sent home

May return to school when fever and symptom free
